⚡ Greek and Roman Deities

Zeus / Jupiter

- Symbols: Thunderbolt, eagle, oak tree, crown
- Colors: Gold, royal blue, deep indigo
- Energy: Authority, justice, divine masculine leadership, sky energy
- Alignment Note: Generally benevolent but assertive; strong commanding energy. Use discernment if invoking for personal power or justice – requires integrity and humility.

Hera / Juno

- Symbols: Peacock, pomegranate, crown, veil
- Colors: Deep blue, emerald, silver
- Energy: Divine partnership, sacred union, commitment, feminine sovereignty
- Alignment Note: Protective of sacred vows. Best approached for strengthening relationships or boundaries, not manipulation or control.

Poseidon / Neptune

- Symbols: Trident, dolphin, horse, sea shells
- Colors: Aqua, sea green, deep turquoise
- Energy: Oceanic flow, emotional depth, subconscious power, intuition
- Alignment Note: Powerful emotional energy. Not ideal for those struggling with emotional instability; requires grounding when connecting.

Hades / Pluto

- Symbols: Helm of invisibility, cypress, black stallion, key
- Colors: Black, maroon, obsidian



- Energy: Transformation, shadow work, death and rebirth, ancestral gateways
- Alignment Note: Shadow-aligned but not evil. Approach with respect and readiness for deep inner transformation. Not recommended for casual invocation.

Demeter / Ceres

- Symbols: Wheat, torch, cornucopia, poppy flower
- Colors: Green, gold, ochre
- Energy: Nurturing, abundance, fertility, harvest cycles
- Alignment Note: Safe, gentle, earth-centered. Good for prosperity and seasonal renewal rituals.

Persephone / Proserpina

- Symbols: Pomegranate, spring flowers, torch
- Colors: Soft pink, green, white, deep red
- Energy: Transition, renewal, duality (light and dark balance)
- Alignment Note: Beautiful for those exploring personal rebirth or healing trauma. Approach with gentleness; she mirrors transformation.

Aphrodite / Venus

- Symbols: Seashell, dove, rose, mirror
- Colors: Pink, gold, coral
- Energy: Love, beauty, sensuality, self-worth
- Alignment Note: Positive and heart-centered when approached from self-love; avoid invocation for control, lust, or obsession – energy rebounds.

Apollo

- Symbols: Lyre, laurel wreath, sun, bow and arrows
- Colors: Gold, yellow, white
- Energy: Light, clarity, truth, prophecy, creativity, music



- Alignment Note: Safe and radiant. Excellent for illumination, creative work, and guidance through clarity.

Artemis / Diana

- Symbols: Crescent moon, stag, bow and arrows
- Colors: Silver, forest green, white
- Energy: Independence, intuition, protection of women and animals, moon cycles
- Alignment Note: Excellent for empowerment and boundary work. Protective, not shadowed.

Athena / Minerva

- Symbols: Owl, olive branch, shield, spear
- Colors: Gray, silver, gold
- Energy: Wisdom, discernment, strategy, intellectual power
- Alignment Note: Safe and empowering. Ideal for decision-making, truth, and wisdom rituals.

Hermes / Mercury

- Symbols: Caduceus, winged sandals, traveler's cap
- Colors: Yellow, light blue, silver
- Energy: Communication, travel, messages, synchronicities, quick thinking
- Alignment Note: Playful, trickster energy. Lighthearted but can be chaotic – use grounding if calling for assistance with clarity.

Ares / Mars

- Symbols: Spear, helmet, boar, torch
- Colors: Red, bronze, black
- Energy: Action, protection, conflict resolution, courage
- Alignment Note: Intense and fiery. Not ideal for peaceful work; best used for assertive boundary or defense energy. Avoid if prone to anger.



Hestia / Vesta

- Symbols: Hearth, flame, kettle, home fire
- Colors: Orange, gold, warm white
- Energy: Home, comfort, sanctuary, divine stillness
- Alignment Note: Gentle, grounding, beautiful for inner peace, meditation, and sacred space work.

Dionysus / Bacchus

- Symbols: Grapevine, ivy, panther, chalice
- Colors: Purple, wine red, gold
- Energy: Ecstasy, celebration, creative freedom, release of repression
- Alignment Note: Can lead to imbalance if over-invoked. Works best for releasing guilt and reconnecting with joy, not indulgence.

Eros / Cupid

- Symbols: Bow, arrow, torch, wings
- Colors: Pink, rose gold, red
- Energy: Passion, romantic connection, emotional union
- Alignment Note: Use carefully – light energy, but intention shapes outcome.

Hecate (Greek only)

- Symbols: Keys, torches, crossroads, dogs, moon
- Colors: Black, purple, silver
- Energy: Magic, intuition, crossroads, psychic awakening, shadow healing
- Alignment Note: Powerful but not for beginners. Requires firm energetic boundaries. Excellent for protection and transition work if you are confident in energy clearing.



Egyptian Deities

Ra

- **Symbols:** Sun disk, falcon, serpent, solar barque
- **Colors:** Gold, red, orange, white
- **Energy:** Creation, illumination, vitality, solar consciousness
- **Alignment Note:** Safe but very strong masculine fire energy. Ideal for empowerment, confidence, and solar meditations. Best worked with in morning or daylight rituals.

Isis

- **Symbols:** Wings, throne, ankh, moon crown
- **Colors:** Indigo, silver, royal blue, gold
- **Energy:** Divine feminine power, magic, rebirth, nurturing, sacred balance
- **Alignment Note:** Deeply compassionate, powerful, and healing. Excellent for emotional renewal and spiritual initiation. A guiding energy for intuitive and priestess work.

Osiris

- **Symbols:** Crook and flail, green skin, white crown
- **Colors:** Green, white, gold
- **Energy:** Resurrection, cycles of life and death, regeneration, fertility
- **Alignment Note:** Safe when approached with reverence. Teaches patience and renewal through endings. Best for shadow healing or ancestral release rituals.



Horus

- **Symbols:** Eye of Horus, falcon, solar disk
- **Colors:** Gold, blue, sky tones
- **Energy:** Vision, protection, royal power, clarity, courage
- **Alignment Note:** Positive solar energy. Excellent for protection and clairvoyance. Balances intuition with strength.

Anubis

- **Symbols:** Jackal, scales, key of life, black lotus
- **Colors:** Black, silver, deep blue
- **Energy:** Death transitions, protection, spiritual guidance, truth
- **Alignment Note:** Shadow-aligned but benevolent. Perfect for mediumship or grief healing. Best for advanced practitioners comfortable navigating spiritual thresholds.

Hathor

- **Symbols:** Cow, mirror, sistrum, sun disk between horns
- **Colors:** Pink, turquoise, gold, white
- **Energy:** Love, music, sensuality, joy, creativity, celebration
- **Alignment Note:** Gentle and uplifting. Safe for heart-centered work and divine feminine embodiment. Great for sound healing and beauty rituals.

Thoth

- **Symbols:** Ibis, moon, writing tablet, stylus
- **Colors:** Silver, deep indigo, violet
- **Energy:** Wisdom, sacred knowledge, communication, spiritual law
- **Alignment Note:** Highly intellectual and stable energy. Excellent for channeling, writing, or studying sacred geometry. Balanced and safe.



Sekhmet

- **Symbols:** Lioness, solar disk, flame, scepter
- **Colors:** Red, gold, orange, black
- **Energy:** Fire, transformation, divine justice, courage, destruction of negativity
- **Alignment Note:** Fierce and cleansing. Works best when your intention is pure – misuse can trigger energetic backlash. Not ideal for beginners or those in emotional turmoil.

Bastet

- **Symbols:** Cat, lioness, perfume jar, sistrum
- **Colors:** Black, gold, turquoise
- **Energy:** Home protection, intuition, sensuality, feminine guardianship
- **Alignment Note:** Protective and nurturing. Ideal for home cleansing, intuitive work, and connecting with feline guides. Safe and approachable.

Ma'at

- **Symbols:** Feather of truth, scales, wings
- **Colors:** White, silver, light blue
- **Energy:** Balance, order, truth, divine justice
- **Alignment Note:** Harmonizing and uplifting. Works well in spiritual alignment or karmic balance rituals. Safe for all levels.

Nephthys

- **Symbols:** Temple headdress, hawk, dusk sky
- **Colors:** Deep indigo, black, silver
- **Energy:** Transitions, dreams, endings, psychic protection
- **Alignment Note:** Gentle but connected to the veil between worlds. Supportive in grief or intuitive work but best used in calm emotional states.



Ptah

- **Symbols:** Djed pillar, staff of creation, ankh
- **Colors:** Emerald, copper, white
- **Energy:** Manifestation, craftsmanship, divine architecture
- **Alignment Note:** Safe, grounding, and empowering. Great for creators and builders of spiritual or artistic projects.

Sobek

- **Symbols:** Crocodile, water, papyrus
- **Colors:** Green, teal, gold
- **Energy:** Power, instinct, survival, and flow
- **Alignment Note:** Elementally primal; not negative but can stir unconscious drives. Best for grounding and courage work, not emotional healing.

Tefnut and Shu

- **Symbols:** Raindrop, lion, air currents, sun disk
- **Colors:** Blue, gold, white
- **Energy:** Elemental balance – Tefnut (moisture, rain, divine feminine); Shu (air, breath, divine masculine)
- **Alignment Note:** Safe elemental forces, excellent for energy balancing meditations.

Bastet and Sekhmet Dual Aspect

- **Symbols:** Cat and lioness, twin crowns, sun disk
- **Colors:** Black and gold
- **Energy:** Dual aspects of gentleness and ferocity; sacred feminine protector in light and shadow
- **Alignment Note:** Best for advanced lightworkers familiar with polarity work. Approach with reverence and focus on balance, not dominance.



Norse Deities

Odin

- Symbols: Ravens (Huginn and Muninn), spear (Gungnir), wolves, throne, runes
- Colors: Deep gray, navy blue, silver, black
- Energy: Wisdom, knowledge, foresight, magic, initiation, strategy
- Alignment Note: Ancient and powerful; works best with disciplined seekers of truth and those studying higher wisdom or runic magic. Not ideal for beginners – his lessons can manifest as life trials.

Frigg

- Symbols: Spindle, keys, clouds, hawks
- Colors: Sky blue, white, soft green
- Energy: Divine motherhood, foresight, family protection, intuition
- Alignment Note: Gentle and nurturing but also firm. Excellent for family harmony, intuitive development, and domestic blessings. Safe for all practitioners.

Freya

- Symbols: Cats, falcon feathers, amber, chariot
- Colors: Rose gold, deep pink, amber, green
- Energy: Love, sensuality, magic (Seiðr), empowerment, transformation
- Alignment Note: Extremely magnetic and heart-centered. Wonderful for self-love and confidence. Approach with respect – her energy magnifies emotions and desires.

Thor

- Symbols: Hammer (Mjölfnir), lightning, oak tree, goats
- Colors: Red, brown, gold, electric blue
- Energy: Strength, protection, grounding, thunder, cleansing



- Alignment Note: Safe and stabilizing when invoked for courage or defense. Very physical, masculine energy – excellent for protection work or clearing heavy energy.

Loki

- Symbols: Fire, serpents, masks, keys, knots
- Colors: Red, black, gold, orange
- Energy: Chaos, change, trickery, transformation, shadow alchemy
- Alignment Note: Shadow-aligned. Not inherently evil but unpredictable. Only advanced practitioners should engage – he reveals truth through disruption and tests emotional control.

Freyr

- Symbols: Boar, golden antler, ship (Skíðblaðnir), phallus
- Colors: Green, gold, warm brown
- Energy: Abundance, fertility, peace, masculine balance, prosperity
- Alignment Note: Benevolent and kind; excellent for manifestation, balance, and connection with nature spirits. Safe and heart-centered.

Hel

- Symbols: Half-black, half-white visage, skulls, roots, serpents
- Colors: Black, white, gray, blue
- Energy: Death, endings, rebirth, shadow integration
- Alignment Note: Shadow-aligned but not dark in intention. Only for those comfortable facing mortality or deep emotional transformation. Beautiful energy for release and ancestral healing.

Baldur

- Symbols: Mistletoe, light, crystal, shining aura
- Colors: White, gold, sky blue
- Energy: Purity, innocence, divine light, rebirth



- Alignment Note: Uplifting and radiant; safe for all practitioners. Excellent for new beginnings and spiritual renewal.

Tyr

- Symbols: Sword, scales, wolf, right hand
- Colors: Silver, gray, red
- Energy: Justice, honor, self-sacrifice, courage
- Alignment Note: Steadfast and protective. Good for truth, fairness, and commitment to moral integrity. Safe but intense – his energy tests authenticity.

Sif

- Symbols: Golden hair, wheat, harvest tools
- Colors: Gold, green, amber
- Energy: Fertility, earth abundance, family, growth
- Alignment Note: Gentle and nurturing; safe for abundance, family stability, and grounding rituals.

Skadi

- Symbols: Snowflake, bow, wolf, mountains
- Colors: Ice blue, white, silver
- Energy: Independence, winter strength, survival, emotional detachment
- Alignment Note: Cold but empowering energy. Great for independence and reclaiming self-trust. Best worked with during times of emotional clarity, not sorrow.

Njord

- Symbols: Sea, ship, fish, wind
- Colors: Aqua, navy, gray
- Energy: Prosperity, ocean flow, trade, emotional calm



- Alignment Note: Peaceful and balancing. Excellent for releasing emotional turbulence and invoking serenity through water element.

Bragi

- Symbols: Harp, poetry, mead, golden cup
- Colors: Gold, burgundy, amber
- Energy: Inspiration, creativity, storytelling, eloquence
- Alignment Note: Uplifting, artistic, and safe. Ideal for writers, musicians, or spiritual teachers seeking creative clarity.

Idunn

- Symbols: Apples, basket, flowers, youth
- Colors: Green, gold, light yellow
- Energy: Renewal, vitality, rejuvenation, eternal youth
- Alignment Note: Gentle, rejuvenating, and safe for all practitioners. Perfect for health, vitality, and longevity energy work.

Eir

- Symbols: Healing herbs, cup, white cloth
- Colors: Pale green, white, soft gold
- Energy: Healing, compassion, grace
- Alignment Note: Safe and heart-centered. A Norse goddess of healing who assists in gentle recovery and herbal magic.

Ran and Aegir

- Symbols: Nets, ocean waves, seashells, chalices
- Colors: Deep blue, teal, silver
- Energy: The sea's dual nature – beauty and danger; depth of emotion
- Alignment Note: Oceanic energy; can be unpredictable. Advanced practitioners only – approach with grounding and respect for water's dual aspects.



Celtic and Druidic Deities

Brigid (Brighid, Bríde)

- Symbols: Flame, well, forge, cow, cauldron, reed cross
- Colors: Orange, gold, white, spring green
- Energy: Creativity, poetry, healing, smithcraft, sacred fire and water
- Alignment Note: Exceptionally safe and nurturing. Beautiful for creative inspiration, fertility, and sacred feminine empowerment. Welcoming energy for beginners and advanced practitioners alike.

The Morrígan

- Symbols: Raven, crow, sword, shield, cauldron
- Colors: Black, crimson, deep purple
- Energy: Sovereignty, transformation, death and rebirth, prophecy, war strategy
- Alignment Note: Shadow-aligned but not malevolent. Very powerful energy that demands authenticity and courage. Best for advanced practitioners who are comfortable with death/rebirth cycles and shadow work.

Danu

- Symbols: River, stars, water, chalice, flowing hair
- Colors: Silver, blue, emerald, white
- Energy: Primordial mother goddess, creation, flow, life-force energy, fertility
- Alignment Note: Gentle, safe, and grounding. Excellent for connecting with the element of water, divine feminine creation, and earth's nurturing presence.



Lugh (Lugus, Llew Llaw Gyffes)

- Symbols: Spear, sun, raven, wheel
- Colors: Gold, amber, bronze, white
- Energy: Skill, mastery, craftsmanship, leadership, harvest success
- Alignment Note: Empowering and radiant. Encourages excellence and balance between intellect and action. Safe for manifestation and confidence work.

Arawn

- Symbols: Stag, hounds, forest gate, twilight mists
- Colors: Deep green, gray, silver
- Energy: Lord of Annwn (the Otherworld), transition, death and rebirth, initiation
- Alignment Note: Shadow-aligned but calm and fair. Works best with those who respect the cycles of death and rebirth. Not dangerous, but requires emotional maturity and grounded energy.

Cernunnos

- Symbols: Antlers, serpent, torc, oak tree, animals
- Colors: Green, brown, gold, black
- Energy: Nature, fertility, abundance, wild instincts, animal connection
- Alignment Note: Earthy and primal but benevolent. Great for grounding, manifestation, and reconnecting with nature. Respectful approach required – his energy mirrors your authenticity.

Rhiannon

- Symbols: White horse, birds, moon, silver bridle
- Colors: White, silver, pale blue, rose
- Energy: Movement, grace, sovereignty, dreamwork, divine feminine rebirth
- Alignment Note: Safe and enchanting. Works beautifully for healing the heart and reclaiming personal power after loss or trauma.



Aine

- Symbols: Sun, flowers, meadow, fairy wings
- Colors: Gold, green, pink, yellow
- Energy: Love, summer, joy, fae connection, vitality
- Alignment Note: Bright and playful. Great for lightwork, abundance, and fae magic – but remember to set boundaries when working in fae realms.

Blodeuwedd

- Symbols: Owls, flowers, moonlight, petals
- Colors: White, lavender, soft pink
- Energy: Transformation, authenticity, reclaiming self-identity
- Alignment Note: Mixed alignment. Represents lessons through consequence and growth. Best for those exploring self-forgiveness and truth after betrayal or heartbreak.

Epona

- Symbols: Horses, keys, cornucopia, apple
- Colors: White, gold, chestnut
- Energy: Freedom, travel, abundance, fertility, animal guardianship
- Alignment Note: Gentle and independent. Beautiful for calling in strength, movement, and spiritual freedom.

Manannán mac Lir

- Symbols: Ocean, ship, silver branch, cloak of mists
- Colors: Teal, silver, navy
- Energy: Sea magic, liminal spaces, transitions, protection of travelers
- Alignment Note: Mysterious but kind. Perfect for spiritual journeying, dreamwork, and protection during psychic travel.



Ártemis of Avalon / Lady of the Lake (Celtic Arthurian Lineage)

- Symbols: Lake, sword, mist, moonlight
- Colors: Silver, blue, violet
- Energy: Emotional depth, mystery, intuition, spiritual initiation
- Alignment Note: Safe if approached with respect and intention. Excellent for cleansing emotional energy and connecting with Avalon's higher wisdom.

Eriu (one of the Three Matron Goddesses of Ireland)

- Symbols: Hills, crown, earth stones
- Colors: Emerald, brown, gold
- Energy: Sovereignty, land blessing, patriot energy of Ireland
- Alignment Note: Grounded and protective. Ideal for land healing or connecting to earth grids.

Bran and Branwen

- Symbols: Ravens, cauldron, sea, bridge
- Colors: Black, silver, ocean blue
- Energy: Protection, love, sacrifice, ancestral connection
- Alignment Note: Balanced energies of masculine and feminine within family loyalty and heart healing. Safe but emotionally potent.



ॐ Hindu Deities

Shakti

- Symbols: Flame, lotus, serpent, yoni, cosmic spiral
- Colors: Red, gold, magenta, white
- Energy: The Divine Feminine force — the pure current of creation, transformation, and power. She is the life force within all beings and the movement that awakens consciousness.
- Alignment Note: Infinite yet grounding. Beautiful and safe when approached with reverence and balance. Shakti amplifies energy quickly, so work with intention and grounding after activation practices (like mantra or kundalini work).

Parvati (*an embodiment of Shakti*)

- Symbols: Lotus, lion, trident, flowers
- Colors: Rose, green, gold
- Energy: Nurturing, love, devotion, divine motherhood, harmony
- Alignment Note: Gentle and compassionate; safe for all levels. Wonderful for invoking emotional balance, self-love, and family harmony.

Durga (*a fierce form of Shakti*)

- Symbols: Lion or tiger, weapons, lotus, conch
- Colors: Red, gold, white
- Energy: Protection, courage, righteous strength, victory over ego
- Alignment Note: Empowering and safe. Her strength clears obstacles and restores personal power. Approach with confidence and gratitude, not aggression.



Kali (*the transforming fire of Shakti*)

- Symbols: Sword, skulls, garland of heads, flame
- Colors: Black, crimson, blue
- Energy: Liberation, ego death, shadow purification, fierce divine mother
- Alignment Note: Intense and catalytic. Best for advanced practitioners ready for major transformation. Kali destroys illusion with love, not cruelty – but her lessons are direct and fast.

Lakshmi

- Symbols: Lotus, coins, elephants, flowing water
- Colors: Gold, pink, red
- Energy: Abundance, prosperity, beauty, grace, generosity
- Alignment Note: Safe, radiant, and heart-centered. Best invoked with gratitude and an open heart. Beautiful for wealth, peace, and gentle feminine expansion.

Saraswati

- Symbols: Veena (instrument), swan, white lotus, scroll
- Colors: White, pale yellow, silver
- Energy: Wisdom, knowledge, art, creativity, divine communication
- Alignment Note: Calming and illuminating. Excellent for writers, musicians, and teachers. Safe and balancing.

Vishnu

- Symbols: Conch, discus, lotus, mace
- Colors: Blue, gold, white
- Energy: Preservation, compassion, divine order, stability
- Alignment Note: Gentle and peaceful. Ideal for calling in harmony, protection, and balance in relationships and home energy.



Shiva (*Shakti's consort; divine masculine consciousness*)

- Symbols: Trident, crescent moon, serpent, drum (damaru)
- Colors: Indigo, white, steel blue, silver
- Energy: Stillness, awareness, transformation, inner silence, meditation
- Alignment Note: Deeply sacred and peaceful, but transformative. Combines perfectly with Shakti's movement – together they symbolize union of energy and consciousness. Safe when approached with humility and devotion.

Ganesha

- Symbols: Elephant, sweets, broken tusk, mouse
- Colors: Red, orange, gold
- Energy: Beginnings, wisdom, success, removal of obstacles
- Alignment Note: Safe and joyful. Universally beloved. Excellent for new ventures, clarity, and grounding spiritual work into daily life.

Krishna

- Symbols: Flute, peacock feather, cow, lotus
- Colors: Blue, gold, yellow
- Energy: Love, joy, devotion, play, divine union
- Alignment Note: Heart-centered and uplifting. Beautiful for inner child healing, devotion, and sacred love.

Radha

- Symbols: Garland, lotus, veil, flute
- Colors: Pink, white, gold
- Energy: Soul love, devotion, heart awakening
- Alignment Note: Soft, loving, and serene. Balances Krishna's joyful energy with emotional depth. Perfect for heart healing and self-acceptance.



Hanuman

- Symbols: Mace, mountain, open heart
- Colors: Red, gold, orange
- Energy: Strength, loyalty, courage, service, faith
- Alignment Note: Safe and uplifting. Strengthens confidence and spiritual devotion. Gentle protector energy.

Kartikeya (Murugan / Skanda)

- Symbols: Spear, peacock, rooster
- Colors: Red, gold, blue
- Energy: Courage, focus, victory, leadership
- Alignment Note: Safe, empowering, and excellent for motivation and spiritual discipline.
